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Next Court and she hath it and the same day is given to her and Eliz here also.

At which said Next Court to witt the seventeenth day of the same month and day One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine came again as well the afo^rd Thomas Walker as the afo^rd Catherine Dyale by their attorney afo^rd, and the said Thomas Walker by his said attorney prayeth that the afo^rd Catherine Dyale to his declaration and may answer, and the afo^rd Catherine Dyale altho^r at the same day solemnly called Cometh not nor nothing says in bar or Preclusion of the action afo^rd of the afo^rd Thomas Walker, by which she doth Thomas remaineth against the afo^rd Catherine Price off Undeferred.

Wherefore the afo^rd Thomas Walker his damages against the afo^rd Catherine Dyale by occasion of the non performance of the promise and a sum whereto afft Eliz to recover, but because it is not known to his Lordship's Justice here what damage the same Thomas in that part hath sustained, Therefore command is to the Sheriff of Somerset County, that by the oath of honest and lawfull men of his County he diligently Enquire what damage the same Thomas has sustained as well by occasion of the non performance of the promise and a sum whereto afft as for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appeared and the Inquisition which thereto he takes to his Lordship's Justice at Dividing Creek in Somerset County afft under his seal and the seals of them by whose oath he makes the same Inquisition to send together with his said Lordship's Writ to him thereof directed and the same day is given to the afo^rd Catherine Dyale ^{here} also - D^r. At which hind Tuesday off August to witt the nineteenth day of the same month and day One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine before his said Lordship's Justice at Dividing Creek in the County afo^rd Cometh the afo^rd Thomas Walker by his attorney afo^rd and the Sheriff of Somerset County v^r John Burnside Gent^r Relumed after his Inquisition before that at Wirksworth in Derbyshire and on the fifteenth day off August and year afo^r by the oath of honest and lawfull men of his County taken by which it appears that the afo^rd Thomas Walker has sustained damage by occasion of the non performance of the promise and a sum whereto afft beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appeared to fifti a hundred pence and for those Costs and Charges to one pound of tobacco -

Therefore it is Considered that the afo^rd Thomas Walker Recover against the afo^rd Catherine Dyale five hundred pence and one pound of tobacco his damages afft by the Inquisition afo^r above appears also Eleven hundred & One - - - - - pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges by him ^{not} afft also Two f - - - - -
