At which said next Court to will the twentieth day of June and Daud One thousand seven hundred and
twenty seven Come against as well the afo Alexander Hall as the afo William Smith by their attorneys and the
afo Alexander by his said attorney pray that the afo William to his Declaration and may answer thereto
whereupon the afo attorney of the same William says that he is not informed by the same William by
Grant of any answer for the same William to the afo Alexander in the plea and to begiven and nothing
use there off says, by which the same Alexander Remained against the afo William thereof Undefended
wherefore the afo Alexander his damages by occasion of the premises, against the afo William ought to
