

Twenty Eight at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Francis Mercer in the sum of Twelve pounds thirteen Shillings and five pence first money of many kind for sundry goods wares and Merchandizes by the said Francis to the said Philip at the special Instance and request of the said Philip before that time sold and delivered as by and herunto quered may appear and being so there of indebted the said Philip in Consideration here of the day and Year afo at County of upon himselfe did assure and to the said Francis Mercer then and there did faithfully promise that he the said Philip the said Twelve pounds thirteen Shillings and five pence Current money to the said Francis Mercer when thereunto afterwards he should be requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content and altho' the said Philip four pounds eight Shilling and four pence half penny piece of the said twelve pounds thirteen Shillings and five pence to the said Francis Mercer he hath paid and satisfied yet as to eight pounds five Shillings and one penny half penny residue thereof the said Philip his promise and assurance afo in form afo made nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending the said Francis Mercer in that part to deceive and defraud the said eight pounds five Shillings and one half penny to the said Francis Mercer altho' the same to do the said Philip on the first day of March in the Year afo and often afterwards at the County by the said Francis Mercer he was thereunto requested hath not paid or to him for the same in any wise Contented but the same to him hitherto to pay or in any sort to Content hath refused and shew doth refuse and deny whereupon he shew he is worse and hath done damage to the value of sixteen pounds Money afo and thereupon he brings this suite vs. Philip Taylor & Edward Rogers & Deo Roe -
