 Prove the Bound of four Hundred Acres Land belonging to Francis Saucake being  
 a part of two tracts of Land Belonging to Adam Heatch, one called some by chance of

 Standing by a Mulberry post Marked with sixteen Notches & a large stooping white Oak  
 Near y<sup>e</sup> fork of a Glade about one Hundred yards to y<sup>e</sup> Southward of Jud. Brees House is  
 the third Bound of y<sup>e</sup> said Land said out for the S. Saucake this Depout. further deposes  
 y<sup>e</sup> the line with a straight line of Marked trees to y<sup>e</sup> first Bound. being a marked white Oak
