Carter or any or either of them or any or either of their heirs Exors or assigns do and shall well and lawfully pay unto to be paid unto the said Orphan the sum of Twenty one pound Eighteen shillings and four pence Curr. according to a writ of said Dec. when they shall attain to full age according to act of Assembly in full here provided & there is above obligation to be paid of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
