 merit. if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he
 might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at
 dividing week the third Tuesday of August then next to satisfy John Sunstall as well of Balertam
 debt of four hundred pounds Sterling money of Great Britain which the said John Sunstall in our
 Court here before the Justices thereof recovered against him as of two thousand and seven hundred
 and sixty six pounds of tobacco which to the same John Sunstall in the same Court here were
 adjudged for his damages which he had by Occasion of the detaining of the same Debt whereof

 found in his Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before
 the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third
 Tuesday of August next to satisfy unto Joseph Muffester of Eight hundred and thirty two
 pounds of tobacco for his damages which the same Joseph had by Occasion of Balertam's promise and
 assumption, to the said Jn. by the said John lately made and not performed whereof he is Comitt.
 and whereupon it was considered by the same Court that the said Jn. have ^{thereof} Comitt. against the
 said John as of two hundred and forty four pounds of tobacco which to the same Jn. by the
 same Court were adjudged according to the form of the Statute there made and provided for his
 Damages Costs and Charges sustained by Occasion of delay of Comitt. of the Damages ad.
