and other persons who have offended or hereafter shall presume to offend in the abuse of weights or measures
against the acts of assembly for the common good or profit now in this province made and used and also of the
Sched. Baileys constables and other officers who have or shall hereafter mislead themselves in the execution of
their offices or have been remiss or negligent in the execution thereof or shall hereafter happen so to be within
our County and of all and every the articles matters and things whatsoever however or by whomsoever in
our County and done or committed or that shall hereafter happen to be done or committed concerning the graving
or any of them and to inspect all judgments before you or any of you taken or to be taken or before our
Justices of the peace within our said County had and taken and not yet determined and proceed thereon
against all or any person or persons so judged or which shall hereafter happen to be judged within our
County and to make and continue until they shall be taken or surrendered themselves, or to be allowed, and
to repair and determine all and every the felonies witchcrafts Enchantments Sorceries arts Magicks bre-
-yng forstallings regalings riotous Indictments and all other the matters expressed according to acts of assembly
of our said province so far forth as they provide and where they are silent according to the Laws Statutes and
reasonable customs of England agreeable to the usage and constitution of our said province and the said
delinquents and every of them to chastise and punish by just laws and amercements forfture, and
otherwise according to the acts of assembly of our said province so far as they provide and where they are
silent according to the laws Statutes and reasonable customs of England agreeable to the usage and
constitution of the same province but we will not that you proceed in any of the cases and to take life or mem-
ber but that in case of such fact you send the offenders with their judgments and the whole matter
depending before you to our Justices of assize Misprissons and Gaol delivery at the next Court of Oyer and
Termination to be held for this our said County be it whenever or whereever to be holden there to be
tryed and we command you and every of you diligently to inquire the keeping of the peace acts of
assembly Laws Statutes customs and Statutes acts and all and every the graveries and that at your
County Courts you make Inquisition and hear and determine as and doing therin what soe Justice
opportunities according to the acts of assembly so far forth as they provide and where they are
silent according to the Laws Statutes and reasonable customs of England agreeable to the usage and
constitution of our said province and further we do constitute Ordaine and appoint you the said
Samuel Hopkins William Blauncer John Jones Wm Fairie Jr Smith Ball hundred William
Stoughton John Aldweare Edw Mifflin John Hoadly James Dashiel John Scott and Robert King
or any three or more of you as and to issue out with precept process and attachments and hold
pleas of all actions popular and of all actions personale of what sort soever wherein it
shall be demanded that the sum of one thousand hundred pounds of Sterling or tenuily thou-
sand pounds of tobacco and all actions personale now depending before you and after judgment
Execution to award in all such cases and actions as according to the acts of assembly of our said
Province so far forth as they provide and where they are silent according to the Laws Statutes and
reasonable customs of England agreeable to the usage and constitution of the same province
which said actions to be tryed we do constitute ordinance and appoint you the said Samuel Hopkins
