And the said Patrick Kerse by Lewis Gale his attorney comes and defends the same and judging when ^{it} and
grants Leave to Imparte hereunto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid
Court here also -

At which said next Court to witt the sixteenth day of August anno Domini One thousand seven hundred
and twenty six came againe as well the aforesaid William Lingoe as the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by their
attorneys aforesaid and thereupon the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by his said attorney prayed further leave to Imparte
hereunto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Court here also -

At which said next Court to witt the fifteenth day of November anno Domini One thousand seven hundred
and twenty six came againe as well the aforesaid William Lingoe as the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by their attorneys
aforesaid and thereupon the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by his said attorney prayed further leave to Imparte here-
unto until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Court here also -

At which said next Court to witt the twenty first day of March anno Domini One thousand seven hundred
and twenty six came againe as well the aforesaid William Lingoe as the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by their attorneys
aforesaid and thereupon the dispute in this action is by the Court and Consent of the parties referred to

make returne of their award to the Justices at Next Court ^{of the County aforesaid} and the same day is given to the

At which said next Court to witt the Twentieth day of June anno Domini One thousand seven hundred
and twenty eleven came againe as well the aforesaid William Lingoe as the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by their attorneys
aforesaid but the arbitrators aforesaid made no returne of their award in the premises aforesaid and thereupon the
Court here by the Consent of the parties aforesaid do appoint Lewis Gale and George Darlode off Somerset
County Gent arbitrators in the premises aforesaid in the stead of the aforesaid John Roach and
thereupon the dispute in the action aforesaid is by the Court againe referred to John Jones, Wm Stoughton
John Caldwell, Thomas Hunglry, Lewis Gale and George Darlode off the County aforesaid Gent or to
any four of them according to the form of the Statute and agreed that their award to be returned
to Next Court and Judged to be on their returne as off this Court, and the same day is given to the

At which said next Court to witt the fifteenth day of August anno Domini One thousand seven
hundred and twenty seven came againe as well the aforesaid William Lingoe as the aforesaid Patrick Kerse by
their attorneys aforesaid but the arbitrators aforesaid made not any returne of their award in the premises ^{aforesaid}
