



Lally you shall cause to be brought before you at your said Courts all writs precepts process and Judgments to your Court and Jurisdiction belonging that the same may be inspected and by due course of law determined. Witness our dear Brother Bead: Leonard Calvert Esq: our Law: Gent: and Chief Governour in and Over this our Province of Maryland this first day of November in the fifteenth year of our Dominion. To Samuel Hopkins, William Clauner, John Jones, William Farris and John Smith of Ball: hundred of Somerset County Gent: greeting We do hereby authorize and Impower you and either of you to administer the severall Oaths appointed by act of assembly to be taken to the Governour as also the Oath of Justice to William Stoughton, John Caldwell, John Maulester, John Handy, James Dashieck, John Scott and Robert King of the same County Gent: or any of them, and you the same William Stoughton, John Caldwell, John Maulester, John Handy, James Dashieck, John Scott and Robert King or any of them you having taken the said Oaths are hereby Impowred to administer the same to the Justices and Commissioners respectively as they are nominated in the within Commission and we write that you and every of you having taken the said Oaths do severally subscribe the test and Oath of Abjuration and for so doing this shall be to you sufficient warrant and authority hereof fail not and when you have the same so done you are to certify the same under your hands and Seales to us in our High Court of Chancery with all convenient speed. Farris, and John Smith of Baltimore hundred Gent: pursuant to the Direction to them directed administer the severall Oaths appointed by act of assembly to be taken to the Governour and the accustomed oath of Justice to Wm. Stoughton, John Caldwell, John Maulester, John Handy, James Dashieck and John Scott who severally take the same and subscribe the Oath of Abjuration and test and take their places, and thereupon afterwards the said William Stoughton, John Caldwell, John Maulester, John Handy, James Dashieck and John Scott administered the same Oaths, to Wm. Clauner, John Jones, Wm. Farris and John Smith Ball: hundred who take the same and severally subscribe the Oath.
