 Whereas your petitioner is now nearly five years of age and crippled by a wound that I received in King Williams wars in whose service was seven years and have paid my Levies in this County thirty one years but am now become feeble by the hurts I have formerly received and old age which makes me incapable to labour as I have done, my wife is dead about twelve months agoe and two small Children left to take care of I hope your worshipps will take my melancholy Circumstance into your Consideration and ease your petitioner from paying Levies for the future and I shall endeavour to use all the Diligence I am capable of to keep my selfe from being further chargeable to the County and your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray

The Petition aforesaid being read and heard, and mature deliberation thereupon had Wherefore it is considered that the said Daniel Munroe be for the future Levy free, as by the Petition aforesaid is prayd &c
