written — The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bounder Leoni  
Gale do and shall in every respect comply with the laws and orders relating to Guardians and when  
the said Arthur King shall arrive at full age to receive his Estate delivering the same personally  
and quietly & then the above Recognizance to be void and of none Effect otherwise

Ordered by the Court that Daniel Jones William Stoughton and John Handy of somerset County Esqrs.  
meet at a certain place and time by them to be appointed for the regulating of the standard for the  
County aforesaid
