admitted to chose a certain Lewis Gale of the County of Dorset as his Guardian, which is
granted &c. whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the said Lewis Gale take into his care and custody
all the Estate of the said Arthur King both real and Personal, and that he give security to comply
with the guardian ship of the said Arthur King according to law &c.

Whereupon the said Lewis Gale together with George Dashiell and Thomas Hay-
ward his security all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged them-
selves to owe and be indebted unto the said Arthur King in the sum of three hundred p^d
Curr. money of manland to be levied upon his goods and Chattell Lands or tenements for the
Use of the said Arthur King his heirs or assigns if default be made in the Condition hereunder-
written — The Condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Lewis
Gale do and shall in every respect comply with the laws and orders relating to Guardians and when
the said Arthur King shall arrive at full age to receive his Estate ~~delivered up the same peacefully~~
and quietly &c. then the above Recognizance to be void and of None Effect otherwise &c.

Dorset. } the Pocumotee Indian Town, humbly sheweth — That your petitioner and the Indians

under him have a piece of Land in the County and Commonly known by the Name of Pocumotee
Indian Town the boundaries whereof are like to be lost and the witnesses to prove them ancient
and Indian Your petitioner therefore humbly prays your worship's wife Issue
a Commission to such persons as you shall think proper to examine witnesses to perpetuate
the boundaries thereof according to the form of the act of a Assembly in that Case made by

The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon
had &c. Wherefore it is considered by the Justice here that a Commission Issue to the said Daniel King
of Pocumotee Indian Town as by the petition aforesaid is granted, and that Lewis Gale, John Scott, Francis
Allen, and W^m. Handy of somerset County Gentlemen be Commissioners and execute the same Commission
according to Law &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Jones William Stoughton and John Handy of somerset County Gent.
meet at a certain place and time by them to be appointed for the regulating of the Standard for the
County &c.

William Jones of Great Marney appointed by the Court preb master for the Bay side for the ensuing year
W^m. Fassitt Junr. appointed prebmaster for the sea side for the ensuing year &c.
