Whereas a certain Mary Richards had served out her indentured and all her runaway time before this Court adjudged the eighteenth day of September last, AND whereupon comes now here into Court John Turpin of Somerset County Gent and brings with him the said Mary Richards, and prays that she may be adjudged to serve him for thirty days Runaway time, &c. Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the said Mary Richards serve the said John Turpin his honor or assigns till Christmas next which is adjudged full Satisfaction for the Runaway time as aforesaid.

Mary Richards } Whereas a certain John Roach of Somerset County Comes here into Court
Judge } in his proper person, and makes it appear to the same Court, that he had paid
and Expended after a certain Mary Richards, when she was his Servant, and run-
away five hundred pounds of Tobacco, and prays the Court that the said Mary Richards, may be adjud-
ged to serve him for the same according to law &c.

Wherefore the said Mary Richards present here in Court is adjudged to serve the
said John Roach his honor or assigns, (after her time of Servitude with John Turpin already adjudged)
the full time of six ~~four~~ months, which is adjudged full satisfaction for the said five hundred pounds
of Tobacco paid as aforesaid.

Alexander Wordie } To the worshipful Justices of Somerset County, now in Court sitting the
Petitioner } humble petition of Alexander Wordie humbly sheweth
That whereas your petitioner
is in possession of a tract of Land lying in Somerset County called Buckalut containing one thousand acres the
bound thereof are going to decay and the witnesses to prove them absent and infirm, wherefore your
petitioner humbly prays your worshipps to grant him a Commission to Perpetuate the Bound of said
Land and in duty bound your Petitioner will ever pray. Alexander Wordie

The Petition aforesaid being read and heard and the Premises considered Wherefore it is
ordered by the Court that a Commission of Peace to the said Alexander as by the Petition aforesaid is granted, and
that John Scott, Francis Allen, Wm. Lane and William Handy of Somerset County Gentlemen be
Commissioners and Execute the same Commission according to Law, whereupon the said John Scott, Francis
Allen Commissioners present here in Court were shown to Execute the same Commission according to
Law &c.
