Whereupon the said Alexander Wordie being present hereinafore is ordered to give recognizance
for his good behaviour and appearance at the next Court to be held for Somerset County at Dividing Creek
the third Tuesday of March next &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Alexander Wordie with George Dashell his security both
present hereinafore acknowledged themselves to owe and stand justly indebted unto his Lordship the
right Honourable the Lord Proprietor of the province of Maryland in the sum of five pounds Sterling
good and lawfull money of England on their goods and chattels lands and tenements jointly or severally
to be made and levied for the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors if default be made in or
the condition hereunder written &c —

The condition of this recognizance is such that if the above bounden Alexander Wordie
and shall make his personal appearance before his said Lordship's Justice of the Peace to
keep apointed at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next and answer unto his said Lordship concerning
all such matters and things as shall be known and there objects against him on his said Lordship's behalf and
do not default the Court without sufficient cause thereof, and in the mean time to be of the good behaviour towards all
his Lordship's subjects people and more especially towards the aforesaid William Stoughton, then the above
recognizance to be void and of none effect otherwise &c —

Bett^r } sitting the petition of Edward Beacham humbly sheweth
That whereas the bounden inhabitant of land
called Long Ridge lying on the north side of Mernunnic Dams, seems to be something precarious,
your petitioner humbly moves to your worship's to make probate of the same and as uidly bound
shall pray

The Petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature
deliberation whereupon had &c. Wherefore it is considered by the Court that a Commission issue to the
aforesaid Edward Beacham as by the petition aforesaid is granted, And that David Wilson, Francis Allen, James
Lane and John Waters all of Somerset County Court be Commissioners and execute the same Commission
according to Law &c —

Francis Newbold of Somerset County planter is appointed Overseer in nailioke hundred
from Drayes Mill to Morgan's load over the head of nailioke, and to have all the labourers
about Deep Creek to work upon said load &c

Gabriel Cooper appointed Overseer of the loads in nailioke hundred in stead of John
Hooftington and that he ^{make good & pay way} pass through the Marsh to the river side where the ferry is kept over
to Eelins &c
