

Angello Atkinson } To the worshipful Justice of Somerset County in Court now sitting the hum-
ble petition of Angello Atkinson, prays your worships that they will be
pleased for to grant a commission to ascertain the bounds of a certain tract of
Land called Hoopers purchase and your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray, Angello Atkinson —

The Petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had &c.
Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that a commission should be granted to the said Angello —
Atkinson as by the petition aforesaid is prayed, and that, John Scott, Wm Lane, Wm Handy and Robert Mitchell
of Somerset County Gent. be Commissioners and Execute the same Commission according to Law &c.

UPON the motion of Hugh Porter of Somerset County Gent. to this Court for to have the house (at a Court house)
where Philip Taylor now lives, and the land belonging to the Court house for pasturing &c.
Whereupon the Court agrees with the said Hugh Porter for to pay unto Mr John Caldwell two hundred
and sixteen pounds of tobacco being due for quit rents of the said land, and ^{the said Hugh Porter} ~~the said Hugh Porter~~ should have and use the said House
and Land for one year commencing this term; and for every year after that, the said Hugh Porter
shall have use the said House and Land; to pay to the use of Somerset County three hundred hundred pounds
of tobacco &c.

Jno Bunnell of Somerset County Gent. graduate in law, his Commission as high Sheriff of the County
aforesaid who took the severall oaths to the Government, with the oath of fidelity, and Subscribed the oath of
abjuration and test, and put bond according to Law &c.

Hugh Porter and Jno Dennis Junr. of the County aforesaid is offered as his deputy, and is approved of
and took the severall oaths to the Government, with the oath of fidelity, and Subscribed the oath
of abjuration and test &c.

James Martin and Jno Handy of Somerset County Gent for the future to have three thousand six hundred
pounds of tobacco each year for keeping ferry, at their respective places &c.

UPON the Petition of Day Scott for to have John Levi Gale assigned as his Comissary against
Wm Francis Allen &c. thereupon the said John Levi Gale is assigned as Comissary for the said Day Scott
in the cause aforesaid &c.

UPON the petition of Robert Rice for to have John Levi Gale of Somerset County Esq. assigned as his Com-
missary against Nehemiah Holland &c. Thereupon the said John Levi Gale is by the Court assigned as Comissary for
the said Robert Rice in the cause aforesaid &c.

The Court agrees with Jno Bishop to keep and provide sufficient meat drink washing Lodging
and Cloathing unto for Thomas Williams an Object (meat for such an Object to have 2 wear) and
he to have after the rate of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco of year &c.
