ficer and carrier one Irish Lien fift of the value of eighty pounds of tobacco one silk hand-
kerchief of the value of thirty pounds of the proper goods and chattells of a certain Ephraim
Wilson then and there being and found him and there feloniously did Steale take and carry away
and against the peace of the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary his good rule and Government and
against the form of the act of assembly of this province in such case made and provided -

On the back side of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus endorsed vizt.

Bills vere Edward Round foreman

Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerett County that he should take the said
John Hambleton if he to answer him and now hereafter to wit the eighteenth day of
November one thousand seven hundred and twenty nine came here unto Court the said John Hambleton
in custody of the Sheriff into whose custody before that time was committed for the cause aforesaid, and
whereupon the said John Hambleton being by the Sheriff set to the Bar, and the aforesaid Indictment
being unto him read he responded instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the
felony aforesaid above upon him imputed, says that of the felony aforesaid above upon him imputed
he is nev'ry guilty thereof, and for trying whereof he putt himself upon the Country and Geo:
Dashiel who for his said Lordship in his behalfe prosecutor likewise -

Whereupon command is given to the Sheriff of Somerett County that immediately before
to come here to see him by whom he who neither doth to recognize him because as he doth of which
said precept the said Sheriff to wit Edw Round foreman. Now heretofore to wit the same day and year
last mentioned made & then that he has here ready to see him as by his said precept he was
commanded, and whereupon the Juror of that Jury wherein he aforesaid being called came to
wit John Scarbrough, Jonathan Ringers, John Brittingham, Thomas Holbrook, Abraham Smith
Edw Round foreman, Isiah Bredale, John George Cugnii Esq, Wm. Miller the said Round ^{Judg} & Bredale who being
duly elected tried and sworn to say the truth in the premises aforesaid upon their oaths do say that
the said John Hambleton is guilty of the felony whereof he stands indicted but know of no
goods or chattells that he had at the time of the felony committed or at any time since thence ad:

Whereupon the Juror here valued the goods in the Indictment mentioned to one hundred
pounds of tobacco, wherefore it is considered by the Justice here that the said John Hambleton pay
unto Ephraim Wilson the party defived sum paid off the value of the goods aforesaid amounting in
