The whole to four hundred pounds of tobacco (the said goods being valued according to law) and that the said John Hambleton be whipt with ten lashes on the bare back were laid on until the blood appear and that he stand in the pillory a quarter of an hour and that he be taken off and thereupon as to the corporal punishment so command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do thereof immediate Execution according to the Judgment and sentence by whipping the said John Hambleton at the publick whipping post with ten lashes on the bare back well laid on until the blood appear and by setting him in the pillory a quarter of an hour and afterwards in the same Court the Sheriff Returns that he hath done the Execution of the Judgment as to the corporal punishment so he was commanded &c Whereupon the said John Hambleton is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County where to remaine till delivered from hence by due course of Law &c

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said John Hamilton after to answer &c and now here afterward to wit the Eighteenth day of November One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine came hereto Court the said John Hamilton in his proper person in custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County and being by the Sheriff sett to the bar Indictment Read, is thereupon instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the felony and above upon him impos'd, says that of the felony and above upon him impos'd he is guilty thereof

Whereupon the Jury, here according to law Valued the goods in the Indictment and mentioned to be to: less to three hundred pounds of tobacco, wherefore it is considered by the Jury here that the said John Hamilton pay unto the said Samuel Wilson the party defrauded sum total of the value of the goods as amounting to twelve hundred <sup>pounds of tobacco</sup> and that the said John Hambleton be whipt at the publick whipping post with ten lashes on the bare back well laid on until the blood appear and that he stand in the pillory a quarter of an hour and that he be taken off and thereupon as to the corporal punishment so command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do thereof Immediate Execution according to the Judgment and sentence by
