Whereupon the said Charles Brown at the prayer of the afo' Anne Fox by Francis Allen her attorney  
is adjudged to give & pay all baile to the afo' John Donelson or to whom he shall appear before the  
County Court present here in Court undertaken for the said Charles Brown that if in case the afo' Anne  
Fox shall recover Judgment in the afo' cause against the said Charles Brown or that the said Charles Brown  
shall be herein found that then he the said Charles Brown shall pay the Indemnition of the sum  
of £1000 or tender his body to the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that  
he the said John Donelson will do it for him. Thereupon the said Charles Brown by Lewis Gale  
his attorney appears & Imprisons his next Court.

I command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should cause  
Joseph Holder <sup>late of Joseph Holder late of Somerset County Planter if he should be</sup> bound in his body with and him should safe keep so that he might have his

body before the Justices of his Lieutenancy County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater  
on the first Tuesday of November then next to answer unto John Caldwell ofagles a tresspass  
upon the said ~~John~~ and that thereof he should not fail.

And whereupon the same John by Lewis Gale his attorney complains that whereas the afo'  
Joseph the tenth day of November anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty eight at Somerset  
County within the jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the same John in the sum of forty  
five shillings current money for divers goods at his especial request by the said John before that  
time sold and delivered him and so thereof being indebted the said Joseph in consideration thereof  
afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid within the said jurisdiction upon him  
selfe abounding and to the same John then and there faithfully did promise that he when afterwards  
he should be therunto requested he the afo' sum of forty five shillings current money to the same  
John he would well and faithfully content and pay nevertheless the said Joseph his promise of  
a sum of mony aforesaid unform'd made little regarding butt plotting and fraudulently intending the  
same John in that part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud he the afo' sum of forty  
five shillings nor any part thereof to the same John hath not paid altho' the said Joseph  
the same to do afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid was requested by  
the same John but the said Joseph the same hitherto, to pay or the same John for it in anywise  
to content hath altogether refused and the said Joseph the same to do shal doth refuse whereby  
the same John say he is worse and hath damage to the value of four pounds & threepence  
he brings this suit ~~for~~ <sup>In Justice</sup> John Caldwell plenger to the same John

At which said first Tuesday of November to wit the eighteenth day of the same Month and Year  
Dowd One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine being the day of the return of the said Writ  
before the afo' John Caldwell by his attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the process  
wherein writ was directed likewise gives and makes return hereof endorsed in these words

following videlicet Non est Inventus of John Burnall fles

Whereupon the said John Caldwell by his attorney aforesaid prays that for as much as he has complied  
with the law in order to an attachment he may have judgment against the said Joseph Holder for his  
damages
