Damages and by way of attachment according to act of assembly &c wherupon for that it seems  
to the Court here that the said Betty Gale has complied with the law as alledged

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the said Betty Gale Recover against  
the said Joseph Holder as well the sum of three pounds first money his damages and also all  
196 costs and charges by her said debt laid out and expended about his suit by way of attachment  
against the goods chattels or credits of the said Joseph Holder according to act of assembly in  
such case made and provided &c —

A Thomas Cuterbridge command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that should

for Henry Smith — take Henry Smith late of somerset County planter if he should be  
found in his County and him should safe keep so that he might have  
his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek  
the third Tuesday of November then next to answer unto Thomas Cuterbridge of a planter of Chesapeake  
upon the said &c and that there of he should not fail &c —

And the said Thomas Cuterbridge by Francis Allen his attorney complains against the said  
Henry Smith in the plea and as follows vid —

Somerset County vs. Henry Smith late of somerset County planter was attached to  
answer unto Thomas Cuterbridge of a planter of Chesapeake upon the said &c —

And wherupon the said Thomas Cuterbridge by Francis Allen his attorney complains that  
whereas the said Henry the first day of October anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty eight  
at somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Thomas  
in fifteen pounds ten shillings and eight pence first money of Maryland as by a certain note by the  
said Henry signed and amount hereinabove mentioned may in Court appear and being so thereof indebted  
the said Henry in consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon his selfe did promise  
and to the said Thomas then and there faithfully did promise that he the said Henry the said fifteen  
pounds ten shillings and eight pence to the said Thomas when thereunto he should be afterward required  
paid and satisfied yest as to three pounds and four pence residue thereof the said Henry his pro-  
mise and agreement aforesaid in form aforesaid made nothing regarding but gloating and fraudulently intend-  
ing the said Thomas in that part basily and publicly to deceive and defraud the said three  
pounds and four pence to the said Thomas altho' he same to do the said Henry on the aforesaid  
first day of October in the year aforesaid and often afterwards at the County aforesaid by the said Thomas  
he was therunto requested hath not paid or to him for the same in any wise contented but the  
same to him pertinent to pay or in any sort to content hath refused and shall doth refuse and
