day is given to the afo^d Left here also

At which said next Court to witt the fifteenth day of August and D^r and D^r One thousand Seven hundred
and twenty seven came again as well the afo^d Left as the afo^d Deth by their attorneys afo^d and the afo^d
Deth by his said attorney as before defend^s the force and Injury when he and says that he did not affine
upon himself in manner and form as the p^t against him hath complained and of this he putt^s
himself upon the Country and the afo^d Left in like manner

it is considered that the afo^d Abraham recover against the afo^d William the sum of five hundred and forty
Pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges, by him about his suit in that part
