thirty days after Sight thereof his first or second Being Paid to pay unto J. Winder
or his Order the sum of two £². ten Shillings Sterling Money of Great Britain which said Bill
afterward to wit the same day and year affd at the County and within the Jurisdiction and
Before Sight thereof by the affd J. D. Tucker had the affd Winder in his Lifetime by Indorsement
with his Proper Hand Superscribed According to the Customs of Merchants affd Order to be
Paid to the order of the affd Wm. Allex. for Value Received of which said Indorsement the
said J. D. Tucker afterward to wit d. Seventh Day of June Anno Domini one thousand and Seven
hundred and four at Barnstable Vnd. in Somerset County within the Jur. of this Court
had notice and then and there was requested to pay the said sum of two £². ten Shillings
Sterling to the order of said Wm. Allex. and the same Wm. Allex. in Court saith that
the affd J. D. Tucker after thirty days Sight of the affd third Bill of Exchange & having affd
hitherto hath not paid the affd sum of two £². ten Shillings to him the said William Allex. or his
order and that for want of payment thereof of the said third Bill of Exchange afterward
to wit the twentieth day of July Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and fifteen was by
the said Wm. Allex. protested or caused to be protested the first and second of the same time & date
not being paid According to the Custom of Merchants affd whereof I have J. Winder in his Lifetime
afterward to wit the tenth day of October Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and
fifteen at the County affd and within the affd just had notice and in Consideration thereof &
the Custom of Merchant affd upon himself affirmed to the said William Allex. here faithfully
Promised that he when afterward he should be demanded Required to pay the sum of two
Pounds ten Shillings Sterling to the same William Allex. would do faithfully Obedient & obey
Nevertheless the same J. Winder in his Lifetime and the affd same time his Death
