And the said Thomas Billm by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defends the
same and injury whereof and prays leave to discharge hereto until the next Court and he
will it and the same day is given to the afo^d Clerk here also &c —

At which said next Court to wit the eighteenth day of August and Dow. One thousand
seven hundred and twenty nine came again as well the afo^d Richard Bywater as the afo^d Thomas
Billm by their attorneys afo^d, and thereupon the afo^d Richard Bywater then and there his writ afo^d
against the afo^d Thomas Billm did not further prosecute with effect but voluntarily permitted his writ to
be discontinued — Therefore afterwards vid. that is to say the same day by direction of the
Justices here were adjudged the same Thomas Billm One hundred fifty five — pounds
of stobans for his flesh and charges by him about his defense in that galt sustained according to the
form of the Statute in such case heretofore lately made and provided and the afo^d Richard in mercy
and the afo^d Thomas have therof Recd her —
