thousand seven hundred and twenty nine came again as well the sd John Sunstall as the sd John Bishop by their attorney ap and whereupon the sd John Bishop says that he cannot gainway the action ap of the sd John Sunstall, nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the sd John Sunstall above against him complained, and as to the damage of the same John Sunstall by him by occasion of the premises of that part sustained, the said John Bishop saith and confesseth that the sd John Sunstall sustained damage by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in the part appeared to two pounds ten Shillings current money and not more and because the sd John Sunstall denies not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true praye Judge and those damages above confessed together with his costs and charges ap to him adjudged

Therefore by consent of the Parties ap it is considered that the sd John Sunstall recover against the sd John Bishop his damages ap to two pounds ten Shillings cur^t. money by the same John Bishop in firm ap confessed as also Two hundred & fifteen ———— pounds of 1660 for his costs and charges ap to the same John Sunstall at his request by the Court here and of the consent of the parties ap adjudged which certain damages in the whole do amount to two pounds ten Shillings cur^t. money and ———— pounds of tobacco and sd of 1660 in money & ————
