may be adjudged to serve him for four hundred pounds of tobacco paid for taking her up when runaway
as aforesaid. Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the said Mary Record serve her said Master
his heire or assignee six days for one which amounts in the whole to ninety days also the said Mary
Record is adjudged to serve her said Master for the aforesaid four hundred pounds of tobacco paid as aforesaid three
months or Ninety day^s which said Service of Ninety days for runaway lime and Ninety day^s for the
tobacco paid as aforesaid amounts in the whole to One hundred and Eighty day^s, the said Mary Record to serve
her said Master his heire and assignee One hundred and Eighty day^s after the Execution of her already
Served aforesaid
