Whereupon the said William Simpson with Samuel Shewell and Isaac Ironstone his securitys all present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the said Richard Hill in the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling good and lawfull money of England lawfully and severally of the goods and Chattells Lands and Revenues to be made and levied to the use of the said Richard Hill if default be made in the condition hereunder written

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bounden William Simpson do and shall hereafter comply with the Law in relation to Guardians and likewise deliver up unto the said Richard Hill quietly and peaceably all his Estate that he shall have in his hands when he shall arrive at full age to receive the same then the above recognizance to be void and of None Effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law &c

Upon the Petition of Eli^o Nicholson for an orphan boy named Nohemiah Boniter now in custody of the Boniter &c ordered by the Court that said William Boniter and Nohemiah Boniter be and appear before the Justice of Somerset County Court now sitting at dividing Creek to answer &c

And afterwards in the same Court came the said Wm Boniter and Nohemiah Boniter, and for as much as it doth not appear to the Court here that the said Nohemiah Boniter is abused or misused neither is he willing to relinquish his right to the said Nohemiah Boniter &c

Therefore it is ordered by the Court that the said Nohemiah Boniter return whom with the said Wm Boniter and that he comply with the laws formerly made about him &c
