sidered by the Court here that the said Ann Barton be fined to his said Lordship for
the fact afo^r toward the defraying of y^e Charge six hundred pounds of tob^o.
& that she be taken &c. Ordered by the Court that she give Security for the fine
afo^r due by Occasion of y^e premises afo^r. Thereupon a certain D^r. Gilliland.
Present here in Court under takes for the said Ann Barton to pay y^e fine afo^r.
due by Means of the premises afo^r.

At the prayer of the d^r. John Gilliland the said Ann Barton is adjudged to serve him six full months
for his trouble charge and loss of time when delivered of the bastard Child afo^r, which said six months service to com-
mence at the Expiration of her already servitude and is adjudged free of all fashion for all the trouble charge &
loss of time the said John Gilliland was at, when delivered of the said Child afo^r — and at the Expiration
of her servitude to return her to County Court, & the fees of the County, to be burnt to said County, the
several Officers their fees due by Occasion of the premises afo^r.
