 his solemn affirmation did declare
 if y^e above acct against y^e Adam
 Clark is just & true & y^e Bald. done
 due to this affirmant is Sixty six p^{ts}
 fifteen shill. & one penny & y^e Do.
 further certifies if y^e Don. Fisher
 at y^e same time did produce before
 me his Book of Accounts in which
 y^e Adam Clark stands fairly &
 regularly charged Debtor to y^e Do.

 Book & Examined by me Du Testi:
