and shown to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said William Smith is guilty of the

said James Lindow by reason of the trespasses and by the said William in form as made to the value of ten shillings
and four pence money and for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part assessed to one pound of tenn
Therefore it is considered that the said James Lindow recover against the said William Smith ten shillings and
four pence money and one pound of tenn shillings his damages and by the Jurors as in form as asessed as also one hundred and twenty
one pounds of tenn shillings for his Costs and Charges and by the Court here to the same James as judged which certain damages
in the whole do amount to ten shillings and four pence money and one hundred and twenty two pounds of tenn shillings
Smith be taken &c.

Somerset p. John Blizard late of Somerset County planter was attacked
in answer unto Joseph M^rester of a paper of trespass upon the Case &c.
and whereupon the same Joseph by Leonie Gale his attorney
complains that whereas the said John the nineteenth day of June Seventeen hundred
and Twenty eight at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the same
Joseph in the sum of four pounds and two hundred and three pounds of tenn shillings and so the said
Joseph being indebted unto the said John the said Joseph afterwards to wit the said
