list of Almighty God according to list of assembly in such case made & provided.
Thereunto to come before you or any three or two of you all such Evidence as
shall be to you or any three or two of you nominated by y^e Complainant for deff^{er} of any
of you examine them upon their several Oaths to be by you or any three or two
of you Administred on y^e Holy Evangelists of Almighty God in presence of y^e Compla-
inant for deff^{er} if any touching y^e truth or remembrance of their knowledge or any
thing that may relate to y^e cause afo^{re} & that reducing the severall Depositions
into Writing you send y^e same together with this our Commission under your or
any three or two of your hands to us to our City of Soudert^h with all conveni-
ent speed Witness our hands & Seal of our Province of Maryland this 14th day of
May 1730
