 Rightfully Acted On yet to be duly Executed we Command you if by honest & Lawfull men of
 your Bailiwick you make known unto y^e said Robert Ware that he be, before our Justices of
 our County of Somersett to be held at winding fresh y^e third Tuesday of March next to show Cause
 if any thing for his sake he hath or knoweth to say wherefore y^e said Dor: Master his Execution
 against him of y^e Judgment. and ought not to have according to the form of y^e Recovery and if
 to be him it shall seem Expedient & have you than please the names of them before whom
 you make y^e same known this Writt with W^{ch} W^{ch} Blanner Gent one of our Justices of our said
 Court the twenty fourth Day of November in y^e fifteenth Year of our Dominion &
 Dow. one thousand Seven hundred & twenty nine

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the seventeenth day of the same month one thousand seven
 hundred and twenty nine being the day of the return of the said Writt Cometh the said Joseph Maulester by his attorney
 and offers himself the same day against the said Robert Ware, of the said Plea, and he solemnly called Cometh not
 and the shod. of Somersett County to wit John Burnall Gent^r. made return that the said Robert hath nothing de-
 nor is found &c. Therefore as before Command is to the shod. of Somersett County that by honest and Law-
 full men of his Bailiwick he make known to the said Robert Ware that he be, before the Justice of his Lordship
 County Court of Somersett to be held at winding fresh the third Tuesday of June next, to show in form of &c. and
 further &c. the same day is given to the said Robert Ware also &c.

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the sixteenth day of the same month one thousand seven hund-
 red and thirty being the day of the return of the said Writt Cometh the said Joseph Maulester by his attorney
 and offers himself the same day against the said Robert of the said Plea and he solemnly called Cometh not and
 the shod. of Somersett County to wit John Burnall Gent^r. as before made returne that the said Robert hath nothing
 &c. nor is found &c. and whereupon the said Joseph prays Execution against the said Robert of the damages &c
 in form of &c. to him adjudged &c.

Therefore it is Considered that the said Joseph Maulester have Execution
 against the said Robert Ware of his damages and award unto the full form and effect of the Recovery of &c.
 And also the said Joseph according to the form of the Statute in such Case lately made and provided, Recover against
 the said Robert Ware three hundred & thirty pounds of Tobacco for his Costs Charges and Damages
 which had suffered by reason of delay of Execution of the damages &c.
