Therefore it is Considered that the said Joseph Woodger recover against the said Edward Round his Damages to one thousand and thirty pounds of Gold as by the Inquisition above appears. also five hundred and seventeen pounds of Gold for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that Court agreed to the same Joseph by the Court here at his Request. Adjudged of Damages adjudged which remain Damages in the whole do amount to one thousand and thirty seven pounds of Gold and the said Edward Round

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Elizabeth Dorothy pay to his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary for her fine by the Court Whoson and Impared for and by reason of the premises etc. whereof in form etc. she is Comitt thirty shillings Current money and that the said Elizabeth Dorothy be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine etc. Whoson it is ordered by the Court that the said Elizabeth Dorothy give security for the payment of the same Officer their fees due by reason of the premises etc. Whoson a certain Richard Bywater of Somerset County Taylor present here in Court in his proper person undertakes for the said Elizabeth Dorothy to pay the same Officers their fees due by means of the premises etc. -

Whoson Cometh and was given to the said of Somerset County that he should take of said John Reading etc. to answer and afterwards in the same Court Cometh the said John Reading and being by the said set to the bar, and was also sworn of the Information etc. and says that he is guilty of the premises etc. upon him Impared and is willing to pay his fine for the fact etc. - Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said John Reading pay to his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary thirty shillings Current money for his fine etc. by reason of the premises upon him Impared, and that said John Reading be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine etc. Whoson said John Reading is discharged paying of some Officers their fees due by reason of the premises etc. -
