John Parker - Somerset Isaac Raegoon late of Somerset County planter was  
attainted to answer unto John Parker of a dea of treas upon offfice  
And whereupon the same J. Parker George Darkie his attorney complained that whereas  
as the same John is a good true and Honest Subject of Our Lord the King that nowe is and  
as a pson and Honest Servt of his Government from the time of his Matrity hitherto hath  
Behaved himselfe and of a good name same gesture condition and honest conversation among  
good honest and creditable men and women as well his Neighbours as other faithfull Subjects of  
of Our said Lord the King now and his predecessor Late King and Queen of the realm of  
great Britain was held Called and Knowne and without any Blot or taint or any the like  
hurt or hurtfull name or any suggestion there of imputted and Imbanted by the whole time as  
he hath Behaved and Governed himselfe by Protec<sup>t</sup> whereof the said J. Parker Not Only the love and  
favour of all his Neighbours and other faithfull Subjects of Our Lord the King deservedly had  
and obtained but also his person from punishment and all and singular his goods and chattels free  
and clear from all penalties and forfeitures as the Law in such case Directs hath exact and  
Preserved nevertheless the afo<sup>r</sup> Isaac Raegoon being not ignorant of the promises of his son  
Mere and wicked Malice fore thought Blatting and maliciously intending the said John not only  
in his good Name same credit Esteem and Reputation to hurt Detrac<sup>t</sup> Scandale make  
worse and altogether to blanch and ruin the said John into Evile opinion and Esteem as well  
of all his Neighbours as other faithfull Subjects of Our Lord the King to Endure & take  
but also cause him the said John Innocently to be brought in Danger of suffering corporall  
punishment by whyping and Brawling and laying foyle at the Law in such case Directs  
at allhows Parishes in Somerset County as within the Jurisdiction of this Court on the  
tenth Day of May Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and twenty six these  
false scandealous and malicious words and lies in the presence and hearing of  
several the good People of the County as with an audible voice did utter & pronounce  
and whereas John Parker speaking off and Meaning the afo<sup>r</sup> John is a rogue and a knave  
for he the said J. Parker Meaning stote his Master (the said Isaac Raegoon) new Meaning  
and as the said J. Parker Meaning would Prove it by Protec<sup>t</sup> of speaking which false  
and scandealous words and lies the said J. Parker is not only in his good Name same credit stote  
and Reputation which before was Innocent is grievously hurt by but also the same  
J. Parker Sues of Money and to be paid about the promises as Path Expended  
and Paid But to clear his Innocency whereupon the same J. Parker says he is  
true
