And the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland at the prayer of the P<sup>ts</sup> attorney and is adjudged to give speciall bail to the action <sup>as</sup> whereupon a certain Hutton Hill of Somersett County planter present here in court undertakes for the said Michael Holland that if in case the <sup>as</sup> Benjamin Waler shall recover Judg<sup>t</sup> against the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland in the p<sup>la</sup> or that the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland shall be therin found<sup>t</sup> that then he the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland shall pay the Condemnation of the Court hereupon or render his body to the custody of the sh<sup>r</sup> of Somersett County in satisfaction whereof or that he the <sup>as</sup> Hutton Hill will do it for him <sup>as</sup>

And the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland by George Dashwood his attorney comes and defend<sup>s</sup> the p<sup>ne</sup> and injury where <sup>as</sup> and saith that he cannot quittance the plaintif<sup>f</sup> his action <sup>as</sup> neither can he say but that the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland did a p<sup>ne</sup> upon himself in manner and form as the <sup>as</sup> p<sup>le</sup> above against him declared nor but that the same p<sup>le</sup> ought to recover his damages by reason of the p<sup>ne</sup> mis<sup>t</sup> <sup>as</sup> to twelve hundred and Ninety pounds of tobacco and the declaration in all the word before especially certified <sup>as</sup>

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the twentyeth day of June and Dow<sup>d</sup> one thousand Seven hundred and twenty seven that the <sup>as</sup> Benjamin Waler recover against the <sup>as</sup> Michael Holland twelve hundred and Ninety pounds of tobacco his damages <sup>as</sup> above in the declaration specified <sup>as</sup> Two hundred and Ninety One pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges <sup>as</sup> by him about his suit in that part expended to the same Bem<sup>d</sup> by the Court here off his a<sup>p</sup>nt adj<sup>d</sup> and the same defendant in mercy <sup>as</sup>

G Francis Allen Somersett & Peter Watson late of somersett County planter al<sup>d</sup> d<sup>t</sup>  
Peter Watson Peter Watson late of Somersett County planter was summond to answer unto Francis Allen of ap<sup>t</sup>ea that he render unto him the true and just sum of Eight thousand pounds of good sound merchantable Yeare tobacco which to him he owes & from him he injuriously detaines <sup>as</sup>

And whereupon the same Francis by Seven Hale his attorney saith that whereas the <sup>as</sup> Peter the Ninth day of January Ann<sup>d</sup> Dow<sup>d</sup> one thousand Seven hundred & twenty six Somersett County within the sh<sup>r</sup> of this Court by his certain Wrighting & oblig<sup>t</sup>ory granted himself to be held & firmly bound unto the same Francis in full p<sup>le</sup> of Eight thousand <sup>as</sup> of good sound Merchantable Yeare Tob<sup>d</sup> in Caske to be paid y<sup>e</sup> same Francis wher<sup>t</sup> afterwards w<sup>t</sup> S<sup>d</sup> Peter shoud be thereto requested yet the <sup>as</sup> Peter though often there to requested y<sup>e</sup> add Eight thousand pounds of Tob<sup>d</sup> to y<sup>e</sup> same Francis hath not rendered but w<sup>t</sup> S<sup>d</sup> Peter y<sup>e</sup> same hither to to doe hath altogether denied & still doth deny & injuriously detain where by the same Francis saies he is worse & hath said to y<sup>e</sup> value of Sixteen thousand
