said attorney as before defend. the force and Injury when W<sup>o</sup> - and saith that she doth not  
detain of above mentioned God Cham and Loukelt from the above Named Isaac Morris and  
Esther his wife by W<sup>o</sup> of W<sup>o</sup> Skirvan and in manner and form as the W<sup>o</sup> against her  
hath complained and of this she putteth herself upon the Country - <sup>W<sup>o</sup></sup> Likewise —

Thereupon Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that Immediately he cause  
to come here twelve W<sup>o</sup> by whom W<sup>o</sup> who neither W<sup>o</sup> to recognize W<sup>o</sup> because as well W<sup>o</sup> of which
