like wise — and whereupon the said Stephen Costen his writ and declaration and against the  
said Mathew Horea did not procure with effect but voluntarily suffered his suite to be discontinued

Therefore afterwards that same day by direction of the Justices here were adjudged  
307 the said Mathew Horea the sum of three hundred & seven — — — — — pounds.  
of tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his defence in that part sustained according to the form  
of the statute in such case thereof lately made and provided and the said Stephen Costen in Mercy  
and that the said Mathew Horea have thereof Execution W<sup>o</sup>
