By Somerset County Court June 22. 1727 -

Ordered by the Court that Thomas Humphry's and Adam Heitch both of the County of Somerset lay out a road from the Lever Ferry Road over Wilkesonoc River, to the Presbyterian Meetinghouse, standing on or near the said River side, & said Road to be laid out, if most nearest way, & least of Prejudice to any person on the one side or the other of the foregoing Order it was thus endorsed by. In Obedience to the within Order, we have ordered that a Road be laid to the within meeting house, and it is now marked with our Notch as witness our hands
