Petition -

To the Worshippable his Lordshippe Justice of the Peace for Somerset
County now in Court Sittynge the Petition of Christopher Nutter and
William More Humblye Stewarte that whereas your Petitioners Land here-
after mentioned are adjoining and contiguous, they having all relation to one Bounder-
or near to one another bid Land called Rose belonging to Christopher Nutter and fadre
belonging to William More Part of it, and about in the Middle formerly taken up by John
Evans called mulmule, on which Rose depends, and we having adoynt and mutual desire
to have the bounders off the said three tracts of Land better known and apertained then
now they are, therefore humblye beseeche your worshipp to constitute and appoint such
Gentlemen as you think fitt for that end to take the Evidence, and depositions to said Bounder
or bounders and to do in that case as the Law require, and your Petitioner as in Duty bound
shall pray &c -

North side of Quantico Creek in Somerset County }.

The Petition aforesaid being Read and heard and mature deliberation whereupon had &c
wherefore it is considered by the Court that a Commission issue to the said Christopher
Nutter and Wm. More as by the Petition aforesaid is Crayd, and that John Caldwell -
Thomas Hunglery, Robert Givans and James Weatherley be Commissioners, and
execute the same Commission according to act of assembly in such case made and pro-
vided &c

Samuel Collins (here) Samuel Collins son of Samuel Collins deceased being of full age
his Guardian . . . for the Charing his guardian comes into Court in his proper person and
Prays that he may be admitted to Chare a certain John White of Somerset County
as his Guardian, which is granted &c, and ordered by the Court that the said John White
take into his Care and Conseruacion all the Estate of the said Samuel Collins the younger both
Real and Personall, and it is further Ordered by the Court that the said John White give
good Security, with two Securitys to Comply with the Law in Relation to gardian, and to
deliver upon Seawably and quietly unto the said Samuel Collins the younger, when he shall
arrive to full age to receive the same, all the Estate that he hath in his hand, Real and
personall &c - Whereupon the said John White present here in Court in his proper person
acknowledged him selfe to owe unto the said Samuel Collins the younger the sum of One
