separately levied upon their body, goods or Chattels, Lands, or Tenements for the Use of the afo-  
said Sam<sup>r</sup>. Collins the Younger his heirs and assigns, in case the said John White fail in the condition here  
under written &c

The Condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the above Bound John White do Comply  
with the Law in every Respect in Relation to guardians, and deliver up unto the afo said Sam<sup>r</sup> Collins of  
Younger, when he shall arrive at full age to receive the same, all the Estate that he hath in his hands  
both Real and Personal &c then the above Recognizance to be void & of None Effect otherwise &c

William Furnace brings his negro Boy Aggo into Court and prays the Judgment of the  
Court how old the said Negro Boy is - whereupon the Court are of Opinion and do adjudge the said  
Negro Boy Aggo to be of the age <sup>of</sup> fourteen Years &c

Ordered by the Court that the Clerk and Crier and all other Officers, Immediate under the  
Direction of Somerset County Court, Charge no other fees for the future than according to a Resolution  
in an act of a Assembly Entituled an act for regulating of Officers fees &c made at a Session of a Assembly  
held at the City of Annapolis in the year 1725 Under the Penalties Imposed on such Persons as should  
charge their fees contrary to said act &c

Sarah negro Girl belonging to Thomas Williams is adjudged <sup>by the Court</sup> to the age of Seven Years &c

Lissee negro Girl of James Robertson is adjudged by the Court unto the age of Nine Years.

Robin negro Boy of Henry Miles is adjudged by the Court to the age of Nine Years &c

Whereas a certain Daniel Ordery of Somerset County was appointed by said County Court  
as Guardian, to a certain William Stevens an Orphan, and since that the said Ordery was about  
to remove out of the County afo, and the said Orphan being Immediate under the Care of the County  
Court afo - Now hereat this day to witt the twenty first day of November and Dowd One thousand -  
Seven hundred and twenty Seven, came into Court the said Daniel Ordery and delivers up unto the  
said Court the afo William Stevens orphan afo, to be dealt with according to Law &c

Whereupon a certain Samuel Dorman of the County afo is by the said <sup>appointed</sup> Court, as Guardian  
to the said William Stevens, and that he take into his hands and Possession all the Estate of  
the said William Stevens both Real and Personal, which said Ordery had under his Care &c
