The same command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Robert Wain late of Somerset County Planter if he should be afo Robert Wain found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships county court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November then next to answer unto Joseph Mifflin late Sheriff of Somerset County of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and that thereof he should not fail ~~100~~.

Aid the said Joseph Mifflin by Lewis Hale his attorney complains against the afo Robert Wain in the plea afo as followeth viz

Robert Wain late of Somerset County planter was attatched to Answer unto Joseph Mifflin late Sheriff of Somerset County of a plea of trespass upon the case &c And whereupon the same Joseph by Lewis Hale his attorney complains that whereas he afo Robert the tenth day of November and now One thousand seven hundred and twenty six at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this court was indebted unto the same Joseph in the sum of two thousand six hundred and twenty pdt of tobacco for Sheriff fees and Officers fees & by and herewith in court ready to be produced may appear and so there off being indebted the said Robert in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day and year afo at the County and within the Jurisdiction and upon himself assumed and to the same Joseph then and there faithfully promised
