

A copy of the foregoing declaration and writ was made and sent to be served on the Deft with the writ in the plea afo - All which said third Tuesday of November to wit the twenty first day of the same month and Dow one thousand seven hundred & twenty seven being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh the afo John Murray by his attorney afo and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court here endowed in these words following viz - Copy of your declaration delivered in time of fra: Allenford -

Whereupon the afo Philip Taylor in his own proper person appear, and thereupon the said Philip Taylor at the prayer of the afo attorney afo is adjudged to give special Bail to the action afo, But for want thereof the said Philip Taylor at the prayer of the afo attorney afo is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remain &c. The said Sheriff present here in Court took charge of the said Philip Taylor accordingly - And afterwards in the same Court came againe of said Philip Taylor in his proper person in custody as aforesaid, and there says that he cannot gain say but that he did a sune upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid ^{John} above against him hath declared, nor but that he owes the aforesaid John the afo Six hundred and Eighty One pounds of tobacco, and the declaration in all the words before expressly confessed &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the twenty first day of November and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and twenty seven that the afo John Murray recover against the afo Philip Taylor Six hundred and Eighty One pounds of tobacco his Damages afo above in the declaration afo & prepared as also two hundred and Seventy four pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part expended by the Court here of his afo to the same John adjudged, and the afo Deft in Merry being

And afterwards to wit the same day and year last mentioned, the said Philip Taylor present here in Court in his proper person in custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County afo, and thereupon the said Philip at the prayer of the afo Deft by his attorney afo is committed into the custody of the said Sheriff, there to remaine until the said John of his Damages afo should be fully satisfied &c. The said Sheriff present here in Court took charge of said Philip accordingly &c.

Memorandum the Deft in his own proper person sued out his Lord's writ of Habeas Corpus against the Deft the tenor whereof followeth in these words viz - Somersetts.
