

Mr. Justice lately in our county court of Somersett here to witt, the fiftenth day of
 March and did one thousand seven hundred & twenty five, before Sam^l Hopkins Gent.
 and his associates then Justices of our said court by the consideration of the same
 Court recovered against Tobias Begger late of Somersett County Plaintiff nine hundred
 and Sixty two pounds of tobe which to the same Joseph in our same Court, before
 our Justice at dividing need and were adjudged for his damages which he had by
 omission of a certain promise & assumption to the same Joseph in the county of
 made and not performed whereof he is bound as by the record & proceeding thereof
 in our same court before our Justice at dividing need and remaining manifestly app-
 :eareth, Nevertheless Execution of the Judgment and as yet remaineth to be made
 as by the Intimation of the sd Joseph M^gester we have received & because we
 are willing that those things which in our court and as rightfully cited, ought to be
 duly executed, we command you ^{that} by honest and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you
 make known unto the sd Tobias Begger that he be before our Justice of our county
 court of Somersett to be held at dividing need the third Tuesday of November next to shew
 cause if any for himselfe he hath or to say knoweth wherefore the sd Joseph M^gester
 his execution against him of the damages and to have ought not according to the form
 of the recovery and, if to him it seemeth expedient & have you them & there the names
 of them before whom to him you make the same known and this writ Witness W^o

At which said third Tuesday of November to witt the twenty first day of the same
 month and did one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the
 Return of the sd writ, before his said Lordships Justice, of the peace for the County
 and, Cometh the sd Joseph M^gester in his proper person, and the said Sher^{iff} returned
 that by vertue of his said Lordships writ to him directed, he had made known to the
 sd Tobias Begger, that he before his said Lordships Justice, of the County Court of
 Somersett, to be held at dividing ^{need} the day and year and, that is to say by William Bratton
 and Hutton Hill good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick W^o —

And the sd Tobias Begger altho' so before warned the same day and year last
 mentioned, being solemnly called cometh not but makes default —

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the same day and year last mentio-
 ned that the sd Joseph M^gester have his Execution against the sd Tobias Begger for
 nine hundred and sixty two pounds of tobe his damages, and as also Two hundred & six
 pounds of tobe as by Court here ^{adjudged} ^{and} ^{by} ^{virtue} ^{of} ^{statute} made and provided for his costs
 and Damages sustained by omission of Delay of the Judgment and W^o —
