

Novem Court - 1727 51

In glester lately in our County court of Somerett here to wit, the fifteenth day of
March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & twenty six, before Saml Hopkins Gent.
and his associates then Justices of our said court by the consideration of the same
Court recovered against Tobie Copper late of Somerett County plenter Nine hundred
and Sixty two pounds of tis. which to the same Joseph in our same Court, before
our Justices at Dividing Creek afo were adjudged for his damages which he had by
reason of a certain promise & assumption to the same Joseph in the county afo
made and not performed whereof he is Comit as by the record proceeding thereof
in our same court before our Justices at Dividing Creek afo remaining manifestly evi-
dence, Nevertheless Execution of the Judgment afo as yet remaineth to be made
as by the Insinuation of the afo Joseph In glester we have recovered & because we
are willing that those things which in our court afo are right fully acted, ought to be
Duly executed, we command you by these presents that you make known unto the afo Tobie Copper that he be before our Justices of our County
court of Somerett to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November next to shew
cause if any for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherefore the afo Joseph In glester
his execution against him of the damages afo to have ought not according to the form
of the Recovery afo, if to him it seemeth Expedient & have you then & there the Grand
of them before whom to him you make the same known and their Writs Writs &c
At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the twenty first day of the same
month and four thousand seven hundred and twenty seven being the day of the
return of the afo writ, before his said Lordships Justice of the peace for the County
afo, Cometh the afo Joseph In glester in his proper person, and the said Writ returned
that by virtue of his said Lordships writ to him directed, he had made known to the
afo Tobie Copper, that he before his said Lordships Justice of the County Court of
Somerett, to be held at Dividing Creek the day and year afo, that is to say by William Bratton
and Hullen Hill good and lawfull men of his Bailywick &c —

And the afo Tobie Copper altho so before warned the same day and year last
mentioned, being solemnly called Cometh not but makes default —

Therefore it is considered by the court here the same day and year last men-
tioned that the afo Joseph In glester have his Execution against the afo Tobie Copper for
Nine hundred and Sixty two pounds of tis his damages afo as also Two hundred & Six-
pounds of tis due by Court here ^{according to form of a Statute} therof lately made and provided for his costs
and Damages sustained by reason of Delay of the Judgment afo &c —
