for Jno. Caldwell somersett vs John Trevitt Jnd. late of somersett county planter was  
attached to answer unto Jno. Caldwell of aplea of trespass upon the case &c  
Jno. Trevitt and wherupon the same John Caldwell in his own proper person  
complains that whereas the afo John Trevitt Jnd. the seventeenth day of July anno  
Dom. One Thousand seven hundred and Nineteen at somersett county within the Jurisdiction of this  
court was indebted unto the afo John Caldwell in the full and just sum of six pd. one shillng six pence  
and money of maryland a by his certain note herewithin court produced may appear grotto thereof being  
indebted the afo John Trevitt in consideration whereof afterward to wit the same day and year anno  
at the county and within the afo Jurisdiction upon himself affirmed and to the same John Caldwell  
then and there faithfully promised that he when afterward he should be thereto requested the afo  
sum of six pounds one Shilling and six pence currant of maryland to the same Jno Caldwell  
would well & faithfully content gyan nevertheless the said Jno Trevitt and his promise affirming  
that he informed afo made Little Regarding but gloating & fraudulently Introducing dñe John  
Caldwell in that part to defraud & deceivethe said Jno Trevitt d. afo sum of six pd. one Shilling  
& six pence currant or any part thereof to the same Jno Caldwell altho afterward to wit the same  
day and year anno at the county and within the afo Jnd. he was thereto requested he hath not paid  
nor the same John Caldwell for it in any wise contented But the same hitherto to do hath allog-  
other refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same John Caldwell of twelve  
pounds three Shillings like money & thereof he bringeth this Suite d.

And wherupon the said John Trevitt in his own proper person comes and defendeth  
the force and injury when he - And says that he cannot gainsay but that he did affirme  
upon himself in manner and form as the afo John Caldwell above against him hath declared no  
but that he over the afo John Caldwell the afo Six pounds one Shilling & Six pence  
and the Declaration in all the word before he gryffly confesseth he -

Therefore it is considered by the Court here the twenty first day of November  
and Dom one Thousand seven hundred and twenty Seven that the afo Jno Caldwell Recover  
against the afo Jno Trevitt Six pounds one Shillings and Six pence curr. mony his damages and also
