 promised to pay d. Jos: Mr. Coker whatsoever certain Tho: Bryor of N. Y. and was
 indebted to the same Jos: when afterwards he should be there unto requested & d. Jos:
 in fact says that the same Tho: Bryor at d. time of the making d. note and was indebted
 unto the same Jos: in d. sum of two thousand five hundred & ninety three p^{d} of tob^{e}
 which is yet unpaid to the same Jos: whereas the same Henry afterwards (viz) the
 tenth day of Novemb and Dow one thousand seven hundred & twenty five at Loudfett
 County and within d. Jurisdiction and had notice which said sum of two thousand five hundred
 & ninety three p^{d} of tob^{e} the said Henry by reason of the note and by force of d. Statute
 in such case made & provided d. Henry is chargeable with & ought to pay to d. Jos:
 amounting to the tanner of d. note and being so chargeable d. Henry in consideration
 thereof afterwards (viz) d. same day & year and last mentioned at N. Y. and within
 d. and Jurisdiction upon himselfe assumed & to d. same Jos: then & there faithfully

 hundred & twenty six at Loudfett County and within d. Jur. upon himselfe assumed &
 to d. same Jos: then & there faithfully promised that he when afterwards he should be
 thereto requested he d. Sum of two thousand five hundred & ninety three p^{d} of tob^{e}
 last mentioned unto d. same Jos: would well & faithfully content & pay Nevertheless
 d. Henry his several promises & assumption and in form and made little regarding
 but plotting & fraudulently intending the same Jos: in that part Casually & Subtly to
 defraud & deceive he didd several times of tob^{e} and or any part thereof to the
 same
