Dad of aplea of trespass upon the person &c

And whereupon the same John Scarbrough by Lewis Gale his attorney complaineth  
that whereas the aforesaid John Bishop the tenth day of may one thousand seven hundred twenty  
and five at roversott County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this court was indebted to the  
same Ralph in his life time in the sum of one thousand pounds of tobacco for a sum to  
him by the same Ralph before that time at his esquire instance sold and delivered and so  
thereof being indebted he said John afterwards bid the same day and year aforesaid at the first  
aforesaid within the aforesaid Just. in consideration thereof upon himself a sum and to the same  
Ralph in his life time then & there faithfully promised that he when afterwards he should  
hereto be required he the aforesaid sum of one thousand pounds of tobacco to the same Ralph he  
would well and faithfully pay and content nevertheless left the said John Bishop his promise  
and assumption aforesaid so as aforesaid made little regarding and plotting fraudulently intending the  
aforesaid Ralph in his life time and the aforesaid John Scarbrough since his death in this part to defraud  
and defraue he the aforesaid sum of one thousand pounds of tobacco neither to the same Ralph in  
his life time nor the aforesaid John Scarbrough since his death hath paid or either of them for  
it in any wise satisfied altho' the aforesaid John Bishop the same to do the tenth day of  
may anno domini one thousand seven hundred twenty and six at roversott County aforesaid within  
the aforesaid Jurisdiction by the same John Scarbrough was in the death of the same Ralph  
hereunto requested but he the same John Bishop the same liberto to pay or the same John  
Scarbrough for it in any wise to content hath altogether refused & still doth refuse where  
by the same John Scarbrough says he is worse and hath damage to the value of two  
thousand pounds of tobacco and therewithal bringing this Summons &c And the same  
John Scarbrough bringeth here unto Court the letters aforesaid & by which

Says he doth pledge & did doth hold & kee

And the said John Bishop by George Dashell his attorney comes and defends the same  
and injury wherein he and gray's leave to Imparle here unto unto the next Court and he  
pratly it and the same is given unto the aforesaid Clerk here also &c

At which said next Court to wit the twenty first day of November and anno domini  
one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven same again as well the aforesaid John Scarbrough as  
the aforesaid John Bishop by their attorneys aforesaid and the aforesaid John Bishop by his said attorney  
as before defend, the same and injury wherein he and gray's leave to Imparle  
Clerk likewise

Thereupon command is given to the Clerk of Somerset County that he <sup>immediate</sup> cause
