Henry Hilgwates of Somersett f. Owen Owens late of Somersett County planter was attainted to -

Answer unto Henry Hilgwates of exiles of his gap upon the last day —
Q D: Owen Owens ... And wherupon the same Henry by Lewis Gale his attorney complaineth that whereas
He and Owen the twenty sixth day of November and Dowd One thousand seven hundred and
Twenty Six at Somersett City within w^t d^r of this Court was indebted to w^t same Henry
in w^t sum of four pounds curr^t money by his certain note or writing & coe thereof
being indebted w^t said Owen in consideration whereof afterwards to w^t same
Day & year aforesaid at w^t County aforesaid within w^t d^r upon himself assumed to
the same Henry there & there faithfully promised & when afterwards he shou
be thereto requested he y^d aforesum of four pd^t curr^t money to w^t same Henry w^t
well & faithfully content & pay Nevertheless he said Owen his promise and
assumption aforesum aforesaid made not regarding butt blotting & fraudulently
Intending him w^t same Henry in w^t part craftily & Subtilly to defraud and
Deceive w^t aforesum four pounds curr^t money or any part thereof to w^t same Henry
he hath not paid although w^t same to doe w^t said Owen afterwards first w^t
the same day & year aforesaid at w^t City aforesaid within w^t d^r by w^t same Henry
was Requested but he the same hitherto to doe hath altogether refused &
Still doth refuse whereby the same Henry say's he is worse and hath dam
to w^t value of eight pd^t of Pikenomy & thereof he brings this Suite
L^t Gale & Quayle & D^t Beckfor

And he and Owen Owens by George Dashwell his attorney comes and defend the same and
Injury wherein he and pray leave to Imparte heremt until the next Court and he hath it
and the same day is given to the aforesaid both here also w^t

At which said next court to w^t the fifteenth day of August and Dowd One thousand —
Seven hundred and twenty Seven came again as well he aforesaid Henry as he aforesaid Owen by
their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon he and said Owen by his said attorney pray further
Leave hereto to Imparte heremt until the next Court and he hath it and the same
day is given to the aforesaid both here also w^t

At which said next court to w^t the twenty first day of November and Dowd One thousand
Seven hundred and twenty seven came again as well he aforesaid Henry as he aforesaid —
Owen by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon he same attorney of the same Owen doth
fore defend the same and Injury wherein he and saith that he cannot say the action of
of the aforesaid Henry, nor can he say but that he aforesaid Owen did assume upon himself in manner
and form as the aforesaid Henry ^{abut against him} hath declared, nor but that he said Owen Owes the aforesaid Henry the
aforesaid four pounds curr^t money and the declaration in all the record before his reply conffessed the

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here the same day and year last mentioned
that the aforesaid Henry Hilgwates recover against he aforesaid Owen four pounds curr^t money
plus damage aforesaid in form aforesaid as also two hundred and Eighty four
pounds, off for his costs & charges by him about brought in & paid according to the aforesaid Henry by & for loss of his
Counsel advised with loss of cost his death at New Mexic and doth in witness ther
