Therefore it is considered by the court here the twenty first Day of November and Dond. One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Seven that the afo James <sup>Mary</sup> and Mary <sup>with</sup> of the same Robert Reiver against the afo Tobias Begger Six hundred and thirty Nine pounds of tobacco their Damages afo in form afo confessed as also Two hundred and Seven pounds of tobacco for their costs and Damages Charges by them about their suit in that part expended by the Court here of their afo to the same James and Mary adjudged, and the afo doth in Merit &c

Ordered by the Court that Isaiah Bredale pay unto John Burnat Junr the Sum of two hundred and Seventy pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance Nine Days as evidence on behalfe of the said Isaiah Bredale against Henry Alexander he having made Oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Isaiah Bredale pay unto Rich: Holland the Sum of one hundred & eighty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance Six Days as Evidence on behalfe of the said Isaiah Bredale against Henry Alexander he having made Oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Jm: Scarbrough pay unto Jm: McAlley the Sum of one hundred & fifty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance five days as Evidence on behalfe of the said Jm: Scarbrough against Jm: Bishop he having made Oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Jm: Scarbrough pay unto Wm: Davis the Sum of two hundred and ten pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance Seven Days as Evidence on behalfe of the said Jm: Scarbrough against Jm: Bishop he having made Oath to the same &c

Ordered by the court that Catherine Dighton pay unto John Merrill and Francis Henderson thirty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance three days each on behalfe of his Lordship against her they having made Oath to the same &c

Ordered by the Court that Catherine Dighton pay unto Margrett Merrill, Catherine Jayfield and Sarah Lamberson sixty pounds of tobacco each being due unto them for their attendance two days each as Evidence on behalfe of his Lordship against her &c
