The humble petition of Merrick Ellis and alie his wife most
humbly sheweth

That your Petitioner hath a tract of Land called Lott daughter
part of a tract of Land called Lott, the bounds whereof are gone to decay and the Evidences are
Ancient wherefore your Petitioner most humbly prays that their may be Commissioners appointed
to take Evidences to perpetuate the bounds thereof according to an act of a Assembly of this province
in that Case made and provided and your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray

The petition aforesaid being read and heard and mature deliberation thereupon had
Wherefore it is considered
by the Court that a Commission Issue to the said Merrick Ellis and alie his wife as by their petition aforesaid
is granted, and that Lemuel Gale, John Jones, George Dashiell, and Shilley Lovington all of Somerset
County Gent^l be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according Law

Upon the petition of Nathaniel Hopkins and others to be discharged from the repairing
and keeping the Causeway at Snow Hill in repair &c. granted so far, that for the future all the Male
Taxable Labourers in the Indian ^{Town} and the Male Taxable Labourers in Snow Hill Town is ordered
to keep the said Causeway in good repair, and that the Male Taxable Labourers in Snow Hill Town for
the future be discharged from bearing any other load &c.

proper person and of his own free consent binds himselfe a servant unto John
Gibbens of the county aforesaid, to serve him the said John Gibbens the full term
of two years to commence from the day of the date of these presents, the said Wilem. Bonum
to serve his said Master the full term of time aforesaid in all such Lawfull service as his said Master
shall employ him in or about

In consideration of which service, the said John Gibbens
doth promise and Oblige himselfe by these presents to pay the Levies of his said Servant during
the term aforesaid, and Likewise find and provide for his said Servant sufficient meat drink washing
Logging and Coalting unto for such a servant to have and wear during his servitude aforesaid

Jeffrey an negro boy belonging to George Beale is adjudged by the Court to be of the age of five years

Edward Rownd appointed Overseer of Boqueton Norton hundred for the ensuing year in
the stead of Brue Bellin to bear from Dukes bury branch, to the widdow Tre vills branch and from
thence to the great Bridge over the head of Bozomoke River &c.

Upon the motion of Robert Trumaine to be tax free & granted as granted, and ordered that for the future
he be allowed one pound off tobacco of year &c.
