and sufficient Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays that your worshipps will please to Issue
Commission to four persons to examine Evidence to perpetuate the boundaries of the said
according to the form of the act of assembly in such case made and provided and your Petitioner
as in duty bound will pray - John Jenifer Osborn

The Petition aforesaid being read and heard and mature deliberation thereupon had -
Wherefore it is considered by the Court that a Commission Issue as by the Petition aforesaid is prayed
and that John Spidson, James Martin, Edward Rownd, and James Rownd of Somerset County
Genl^l be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to Law &c -
