P.S. - - - Judicially sitting The petition of John Jenifer Osborn humbly

Sheweth That your petitioner is possessed of about of land in the County and called Ham-
monsey the boundary thereof are decayed, and the witness to prove them ancient
and true Your petitioner therefore humbly prays that your worship will please to Issue
and affix to your Person to examine Evidence to perpetuate the boundary of the said
land according to the form of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided and your petitioner
as in duty bound will pray - John Jenifer Osborn

The Petition and being Read and heard and mature deliberation Whereupon Read -
Wherefore it is Considered by the Court that a Commission Issue as by the Petition and is granted
and that John Doudson, James Martin, Edward Round, and James Rownd of Somerset County
gentl. be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to Law &c -

Thomas Reed a servant to Thomas Newbold comes into Court, and confesseth that he had
abducted and runaway out of his former master Mr. Filmer's Service two days ago -
Whereupon the said Thomas Newbold prays that he may be adjudged to serve him for
the runaway time and according to Law &c. Whereupon it is Considered by the Court that
the said Thomas Reed serve his said Master Thomas Newbold four days for every one day
he runaway and, which in the whole amounts to Twenty days, The said Thomas Reed to serve his
said Master Thomas Newbold the full term of time and to commence at the expiration of his
already servitude, which is adjudged full satisfaction for the runaway time and all trouble
Cost, Damages and Pains that accrued by means of the runaway time and £20 -

Upon the complaint of a certain Daniel Luke of Barnard Castle County in the Colony of Bergenia
against a certain Abraham Smith of Somerset County who detained a certain Amy Luke in his
custody, who had a seat estate in the Colony of Bergenia &c. Whereupon it is Ordered by the
Court that as soon as possible, for the said Abraham Smith and Amy Luke that they be and
appear at June Court next to answer the complaint and &c.
